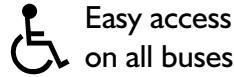

## Easy access on buses



Journeys displaying this symbol in the timetable are run with **low floor** buses which have no steps at the entrance, making getting on and off easier. Where shown, **low floor** buses have a ramp for access and a dedicated space for wheelchairs and pushchairs inside the bus.

**The bus operator will always try to provide easy access services where these services are scheduled to run. In case of difficulty, please contact the bus operator.**

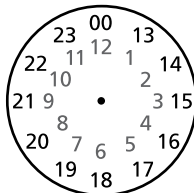
## Using this timetable

Timetables show the direction of travel, bus numbers and the days of the week.

- Main stops on the route are listed on the left. Each journey reads down the page.
- Where no time is shown against a particular stop, the bus does not stop there on that journey.
- Check any symbols which are shown and the meanings at the bottom of the page.
- A route plan is also included in this leaflet.

## Using the 24 hour clock

Times are shown in four figures. The first two are the hour and the last two are the minutes.



Examples:

0921 is 21 minutes past 9am  
2148 is 48 minutes past 9pm



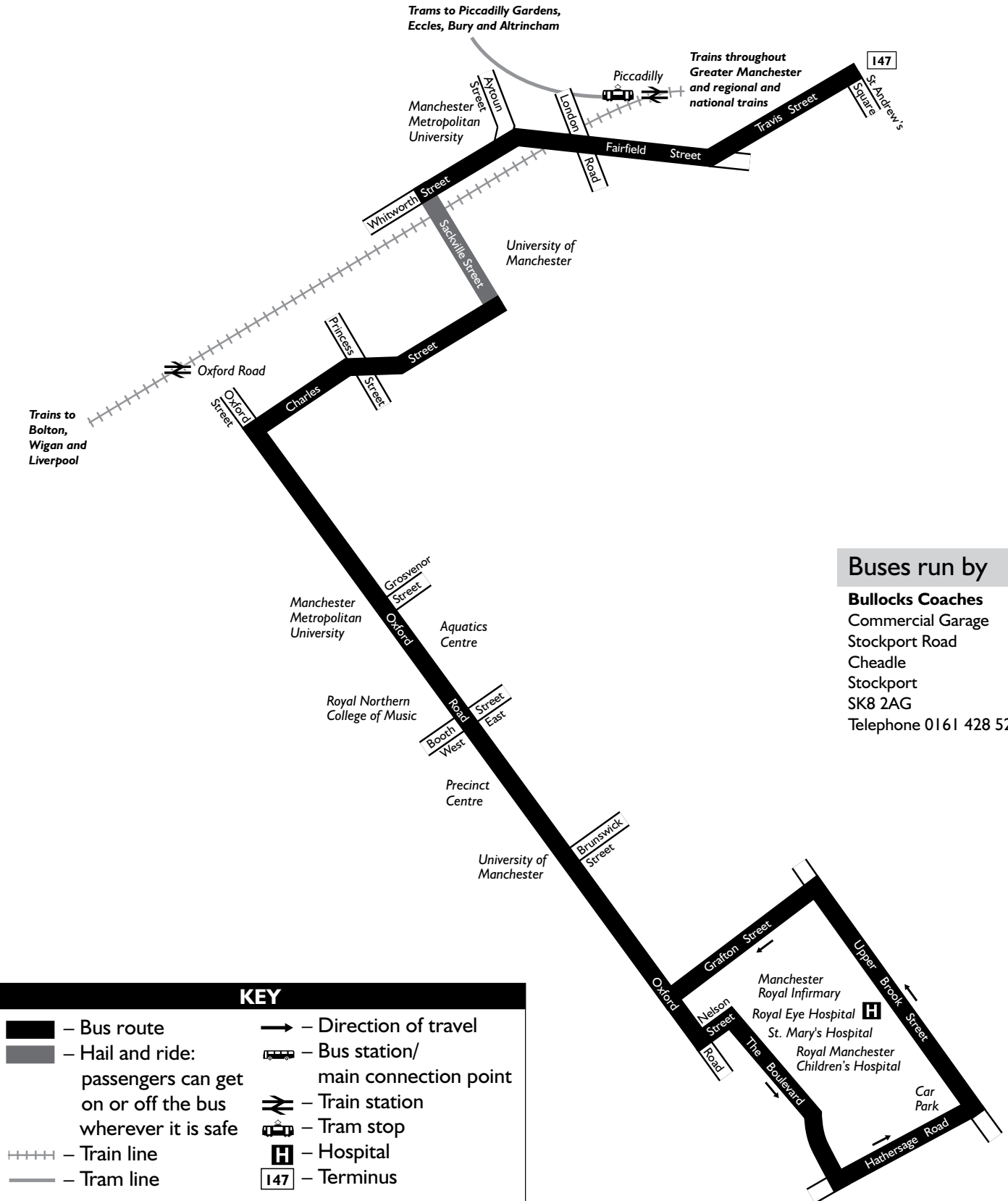










